I have represented hundreds of union members in the Building and Trades professions in individual lung cancer personal injury and wrongful death cases. I also have litigated against tobacco companies and car manufacturers for defective products that catastrophically injured people.

In 2012, after getting elected to city council, I went to work for former State Senator and Santa Clara County Supervisor Joe Simitian, and served as his Chief of Staff on the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors.

Thereafter, I have worked as an attorney in different capacities for companies focused on serving and helping people, first in education, then in the emergency response and recovery sector.

Today, I work as an attorney and technology director for a national homeland security / emergency response and recovery services provider. We work with FEMA and other state and local agencies, in response to crises like Covid-19, Hurricanes and Wildfires. As a result of my work in this area, Richard Serino, Distinguished Senior Fellow at the Harvard TH Chan School of Public Health, National Preparedness Initiative; formerly the Deputy Director of FEMA (Obama Administration, 2009-2014) has endorsed me in this race.



I served as co-Chair of Josh Becker's transition committee and worked on his campaign for state senate. I have worked Assemblymember Marc Berman for years. Both have endorsed my campaign, as well as Lorie Holzberg, Chair of the Peninsula Democratic Club.
- 2. Hate Crimes: Do you see Anti-Semitism as a Hate Crime? How do you propose working on Hate Crimes if you are elected? Yes. I believe it's time to end freedom of speech protections for Hate Speech. I believe the time has come to recognize hate speech on the basis of race and religion as obscenity, remove it's freedom of speech protections, and allow it to be prosecuted appropriately.
